- Opportunity for diversification

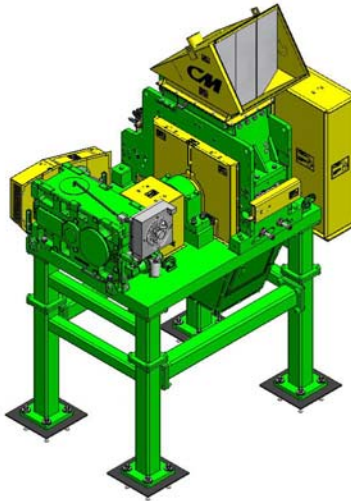
